FEES, CHARGES, AND EXPENSES:

EBER Module

The total cost for the module in which the student is enrolling is US\$2250.

The normal length of the EBER Module is up to one year once initiated, with one month allowed to request and complete final exam (13 months maximum).

At the time of registration, payment is due in full. This may be paid by check or money order made payable to AASS, LLC., or by credit card, at the time of registration. The tuition (payment) shall be paid in full before content and materials are delivered.

There are no charges for uniforms or other special protective clothing. There is no in-residence housing available, and therefore no charges for such. There are no charges for tutoring, the assessment of fees for transfer of credits or fees to transfer credits. There are no charges paid to an entity other than an institution that is required for participation in the educational program. There are no other institutional charges or fees other than those listed below.

The following charges must be paid by the student. Those charges that are non-refundable are clearly identified as such.

Students are responsible for these amounts. If the student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program, the student will have the responsibility to repay the full amount of the loan plus, interest, less the amount of any refund.

STUDENT TUITION RECOVERY FUND (STRF) FEES:

“The State of California established the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) to relieve or mitigate economic loss suffered by a student in an educational program at a qualifying institution, who is or was a California resident while enrolled, or was enrolled in a residency program, if the student enrolled in the institution, prepaid tuition, and suffered an economic loss. Unless relieved of the obligation to do so, you must pay the state-imposed assessment for the STRF, or it must be paid on your behalf, if you are a student in an educational program, who is a California resident, or are enrolled in a residency program, and prepay all or part of your tuition.

You are not eligible for protection from the STRF, and you are not required to pay the STRF assessment, if you are not a California resident, or are not enrolled in a residency program.”

“It is important that you keep copies of your enrollment agreement, financial aid documents, receipts, or any other information that documents the amount paid to the school.

To be eligible for STRF, you must be a California resident or are enrolled in a residency program, prepaid tuition, paid or deemed to have paid the STRF assessment, and suffered an economic loss as a result of any of the following:

1. The institution, a location of the institution, or an educational program offered by the institution was closed or discontinued, and you did not choose to participate in a teach-out plan approved by the Bureau or did not complete a chosen teach-out plan approved by the Bureau.
2. You were enrolled at an institution or a location of the institution within the 120-day period before the closure of the institution or location of the institution, or were enrolled in an educational program within the 120-day period before the program was discontinued.
3. You were enrolled at an institution or a location of the institution more than 120 days before the closure of the institution or location of the institution, in an educational program offered by the institution as to which the Bureau determined there was a significant decline in the quality or value of the program more than 120 days before closure.
4. The institution has been ordered to pay a refund by the Bureau but has failed to do so.
5. The institution has failed to pay or reimburse loan proceeds under a federal student loan program as required by law, or it has failed to pay or reimburse proceeds received by the institution in excess of tuition and other costs.
6. You have been awarded restitution, a refund, or other monetary award by an arbitrator or court, based on a violation of this chapter by an institution or representative of an institution, but have been unable to collect the award from the institution.
7. You sought legal counsel that resulted in the cancellation of one or more of your student loans and have an invoice for services rendered and evidence of the cancellation of the student loan or loans.

To qualify for STRF reimbursement, the application must be received within four (4) years from the date of the action or event that made the student eligible for recovery from STRF.

A student whose loan is revived by a loan holder or debt collector after a period of non-collection may, at any time, file a written application for recovery from STRF for the debt that would have otherwise been eligible for recovery. If it has been more than four (4) years since the action or event that made the student eligible, the student must have filed a written application for recovery within the original four (4) year period, unless the period has been extended by another act of law.

However, no claim can be paid to any student without a social security number or a taxpayer identification number.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL:

Any student has the right to cancel this enrollment agreement and obtain a refund. Please see refund policy below which was approved by BPPE.

Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation to AASS: attention Debranne Pattillo, 610 Noah Court, Napa, CA 94558, USA. If you cancel this Agreement, the school will refund any money that you paid, less any non-refundable charges and deduction for equipment not timely returned in good condition, within forty-five days after your Notice of Cancellation is received.

REFUND POLICY:**Distance Education Refund Provisions**

An institution offering a distance educational program, where the instruction is not offered in real time, must transmit the first lesson and any materials to any student within seven days after the institution accepts the student for admission. The student has the right to cancel the agreement and receive a full refund as described above before the first lesson and materials are received. Cancellation is effective on the date written notice of cancellation is sent. If the institution sent the first lesson and materials before an effective cancellation notice was received, the institution shall make a refund within 45 days after the student's return of the materials.

An institution must transmit all the lessons and other materials to the student if the student has fully paid for the educational module, and after having received the first lesson and initial materials, requests in writing that all of the material be sent. If the institution transmits the balance of the material as the student requests, the institution must remain obligated to provide the other educational services it agreed to provide, such as responses to student inquiries, student and faculty interaction, and evaluation and comment on lessons submitted by the student, but it shall not be obligated to pay any refund after all of the lessons and material are transmitted.

Federal or State Loans:

If a student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid programs funds. If the student is eligible for a loan guaranteed by the federal or state government and the student defaults on the loan, both of the following may occur:

1. The federal or state government or a loan guarantee agency may take action against the student, including applying any income tax refund to which the person is entitled to reduce the balance owed on the loan.
2. The student may not be eligible for any other federal student financial aid at another institution or other government assistance until the loan is repaid.

WITHDRAWAL:

You have the right to withdraw from a course of instruction at any time. It is preferred that a notice of withdrawal be made in writing to the address of the school shown on the first page of this Agreement. When a student officially withdraws from the course, any refund of tuition will be governed by the following policy calculated as previously discussed. No administrative fee will be assessed or deducted from the amount to be refunded to the student. There will, however, be no refund for late payment of fees.

If a student wishes to withdraw from the institution or a course of instruction, the student must contact AASS: attention Debranne Pattillo, 610 Noah Court, Napa, CA 94558, USA. Refunds are processed by AASS when a student has resolved all financial obligations against their school debts, and their student account reflects a credit balance. Refunds are processed within 14 days after the student's account reflects a credit balance.

**NOTICE CONCERNING TRANSFERABILITY OF CREDITS AND CREDENTIALS
EARNED AT OUR INSTITUTION**

The transferability of credits you earn at AASS is at the complete discretion of an institution to which you may seek to transfer. Acceptance of the certificate you earn in the educational program is also at the complete discretion of the institution to which you may seek to transfer.
